Undertake reviews of the TLM-Nigeria Research Agenda to determine progress in implementation and inform resource allocation. Engage partners to mobilize resources for implementation of TLM-Nigeria's research agenda. Prepare concept notes and terms of Reference for various research projects for funding from partners. support the delivery and implementation of various research and innovation programmes. Undertake research, write research reports & facilitate dissemination of findings. Any other duties as assigned by the Head of Programmes and Operations.
