Main Function of the Job:

Provide psychosocial support to our beneficiaries. To ensure success, candidates should have experience providing virtual or psychosocial support services to individuals/groups on issues such as stigma, anxiety, stress, depression, suicidal ideation, and sleep, should be familiar with the latest treatment methods, and collaborate with other mental health care specialists.

Main task:

Administrative/Follow-up:

1. Managing all aspects of a case from the date of entry to the date of discharge.
2. Make weekly wellness check calls to beneficiaries
3. Administering and scoring assessments

Consultation & Treatment

1. Evaluate patients' physical and mental behaviours and health.
2. Evaluate the individual and family systems.
3. Assess patients' functioning within work, family, and routines of daily living and identify areas needing change, resources, and treatment in order to best help each beneficiary.
4. Develop appropriate treatment and recovery plans.
5. Provide therapeutic interventions to individuals, groups, and families as needed.
6. Monitor patients over time to assess treatment progress.
7. Collaborating with the multidisciplinary team to ensure quality service is provided
8. Identify behaviours that interfere with treatment and recovery.
